## Stock Car Tire Rules - Daytona Continental Historic Races & 2007 Season

For the Daytona Continental Historic Race event we request all cars to be fitted with radial tires. Hoosier will be introducing a reduced cost tire beginning October 16, 2006. This will be available through Bob Woodman and Hoosier. The cost will be \$250.00 per tire and the part numbers are as follows: 43590 HSCF (HSC front) and 43595 HSCR (HCS rear). They are front/rear sensitive and measure 27.5 X 11.5 R15.

For the 2007 season and beyond stock cars will be allowed to run any suitable tire designed for the cars that carries a retail price of \$250.00 or less per tire. This means if the original manufacturer's price per tire is \$250.00 or less it will be allowed. The only time a specific tire type i.e. radial will be spec'ed is when the cars will be running at a high sustained speed such as a super speedway like Daytona.
